Magnificent Mountains!

What are mountains and why are they so important?

Geography

Where are the highest mountain ranges in the world? How are mountains formed? – fold mountains and volcanoes. What are the features of mountains and what is their climate like? What is the European region of the Dolomites like? Why is tourism so important in this region?

Computing

Data & information – Children will learn what a branching database is and how to create one.

Children will learn simple programming techniques using the 'Scratch' program.

RE

Children will learn about Pentecost, the Kingdom of God and the impact of these today.

During the second half term, children will learn how and why people try to make the world a better place.

Spanish

Children will learn about Spanish food including words for food and simple ordering from a menu. They will also learn the days of the week and months of the year in Spanish and practise simple conversations.
